SUBJECT: TRAINING FOR NON-JUVENILE DETENTION OFFICERS

POLICY

The Probation Department is committed to providing quality training to all members assigned to Juvenile Detention. The Juvenile Detention Training Officer is responsible for ensuring all non-juvenile detention officers assigned to Juvenile Detention receive the required training.

PROCEDURES

A. Non-Juvenile Detention Officer Orientation Training

- 1. Within 60 days of assignment to Juvenile Detention, each member will receive Orientation Training.
- 2. Orientation Training shall be provided to all non-juvenile detention officers assigned to Juvenile Detention (i.e. teachers, support staff, probation officers, volunteers, medical staff, Behavioral Health Services staff, program providers, etc.)
- 3. Orientation Training shall include safety and security issues as well as antidiscrimination policies.
- 4. Applicable Juvenile Detention Policy and Procedure Review and Administrative Policy and Procedure Review.
- 5. The Juvenile Detention Training Officer will also review general facility guidelines as well as proper interaction and working with youth.
