**SUBJECT: PLACE OF DETENTION**

**POLICY**

The federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act<sup>1</sup> (JJDP) requires that juveniles not have “sight or sound contact” with adult inmates. (34 U.S.C. § 11133(a)(1)(B).)

**PROCEDURE**

- A. The following applies to bookings by law enforcement agencies only and does not pertain to housing orders or jail commitments by the Juvenile Court.

<u>Situation</u>	<u>Disposition</u>
18 - 24 years old with a Juvenile Court Warrant or crime committed as juvenile. No new adult charges/No adult convictions	Book in Juvenile Detention
18 - 24 years old with a Juvenile Court Warrant or crime committed as a juvenile. Also has adult charges/adult warrant	Book Main Jail on adult charges and add juvenile 602(WIC) warrant hold
25 years old (or older) and a Juvenile Court Warrant or booked for a crime committed as a juvenile and NO adult charges/adult warrant	Book in Main Jail as a courtesy hold for Juvenile Detention. Add juvenile 602 WIC warrant hold
25 years of age (or older) and a Juvenile Court Warrant and adult charges/adult warrant	Book in Main Jail for adult charges and warrant. Add juvenile 602 WIC warrant hold
