 - i. Current budget is "cloudy and gray," so there are some concerns with budget and hiring moving forward; it looks like there could be some cutbacks.
 - ii. Array of programming events were described, including ILP program
 - D. Mary Graham Children's Shelter
 - i. 8 youth currently at the shelter
 - ii.Last month, there were over 20 youth, and staffing was a challenge
 - iii. Recent interest in STRTP providers in SJ county
 - E. San Joaquin County Office of Education
 - i. AB109 programs just launched
 - ii.The Delta College 2 factor authentication issue was addressed, and youth will be starting college classes next week
 - F. Probation Juvenile Division
 - G. Probation Detention Division
 - i. Housing 58 youth currently
 - ii.Grand Jury September 30th and OYCR will be visiting 09/23/2025 there is a lot happening in the month of September, so JJDPC inspection in October would be better
 - iii. Secure track youth is considering attending Sac State (virtually at first) and then eventually post-release in person
 - iv. As youth progress through the phases of secure track, they are eligible for/approved by the judge for lesser restrictive programming (like the Camp, fire camp, college re-entry programs, etc.)
 - H. Behavioral Health
 - i. Continuing to serve youth in juvenile hall and working hard on linkage as youth reenter the community
 - 1. Gwendolyn suggested doing a community provider audit of some of the community partners
